The following items were discussed at the Lake Management Meeting held at Lakeview School in Fall 2015. This meeting constituted the Annual Meeting of GWLPOA.

Carol Marvin, Treasurer, gave us a balance of \$2,017.70 as of August 22, 2015. This included the Spring Casino night, The Summer Hot Dog picnic, and the August Golf Outing. It also included donations to the Town of Whitewater for buoys (1,500) and the JNT (\$500) firework donations. The donation to the Minnieska Ski Team (\$500) was given in early 2015. The Treasurer's report was approved.

Pat Koppelman passed out the minutes from 2014 and they were accepted by Tom Potrykus and seconded by Janet Lippincot.

We next voted to approve two new members of the Board. Laura Leslie and Lynn Ellis were unanimously approved.

The Officers of the Board that were present were introduced and Kathy Chamberlain was introduced as a working Board member.

The buoy situation was addressed next. It was mentioned during the Lake Management Meeting that the buoys were in terrible condition. This past Spring, Lillian Roy, Pat Koppelman and Elaine Florczak met with the Whitewater Township Board to let them know that our donation of \$1,500 to the City for the buoys was not enough to keep the buoys in good and safe condition. The City agreed and will vote in the Fall to add money to the budget to aid in replacing buoys in poor condition. They will also notify Richmond County that they also need to help in maintenance of buoys since part of Whitewater Lake is in Richmond County. Lillian mentioned that the day after meeting with the Township Board that Bob Strand took a ride of both lakes to review the situation. He indicated via email to Lillian that she was correct and is working with the Township Board to help correct the situation. Bob is on the Township Board and the Lake is the area he is working with right now.

Lillian mentioned that there will be new Directories in 2016 and that in January, the website will be open to update any information that you would like updated.

There was also a reminder that the next event, GWLPOA's Sock Hop will be held on September 12 at the American Legion downstairs. If you have a poodle skirt or letter shirt or jacket, wear them. Or, wear casual clothes and come to listen to the music and/or dance. Hamburger and hot dogs with an ice cream bar will be provided.
