As part of this commitment – we provide a source of information and assistance to old and new members via the many emails and calls asking about activities on the lakes, permit navigation, boating ordinances, contact info for the Lake Management, Towns, County, and DNR etc. We have partnered with Lake Management and the Towns on a review of Boat Ordinances, and the High Water/No Wake communication process.
 As part of the communication to lake property owners we have agreed to use our email data base to “get the word out” about **Town Alerts** re issues of major concern to our membership. Winter Lake Safety

Color variation in ice may mean ice depth difference
 Bubblers near piers impact ice depth
 Springs on the lakes reduce the depth of the ice in their vicinity
 White ice or "snow ice" is only about half as strong as new clear ice
 Check ice thickness at least every 150 feet.
