### Boater Safety

Boater's Safety 2 Day Courses will be offered on May 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> and June 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 am till noon on both days. Persons from 10 years to any age may take the course. Operation of a Motor Boat and PWC in Wisconsin and Illinois requires the operator or supervising adult to have a boater's Safety Certificate if they were born after **Jan, 1, 1989.
