**Property Owners:** We have had a large turnover of property owners in the last couple of years and for the Goose Roundup we need new owners to give us permission to remove Geese from your property. Please sign the form below if you haven't signed before.

**Why remove the geese?** The geese make our yards and rafts filthy and pollute our waters. We are proud that we have worked together to clarify our water and make our yards fit for our children/grandchildren to play. In order to do this, we need our new property owners to allow our lake people to round up the geese and to enable the Wildlife Services to conclude the roundup by putting the geese in cages.
