A "No Wake" zone means that boats must reduce to the slowest speed they can travel at while still maintaining the ability to steer and make forward progress. When vessels move at these speeds, they produce a minimum wake. A "wake" = waves created as a vessel travels through the water. A "no-wake zone" is an area where vessels are expected to travel at slow (idle) speeds to minimize the wake. Think of no-wake zones as the speed bumps or school zones of the water! If you are not sure if you are making a wake, turn your head around and look behind your boat. If you are making waves, you are making a wake.
